4. No TA/DA will be admissible for attending the interview and for joining the training programme.
5. During the time of interview, the candidates are requested to bring the original educational qualification certificates from 10th class onwards for verification. They shall submit self attested Xerox copies of the CV, certificates, color passport size photograph along with ID proof (Aadhar Card).
6. Certificate from Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India shall be awarded to those who successfully complete the programme.
7. The Candidates who have undergone any GSDP course already are not eligible.
